Audience: Alberta Operators

Purpose:

To inform Alberta operators that, effective March 5, 2026, AER Annual Methane Emission Reporting functionality is now available on Petrinex.

Background:

On February 17, 2026, The Alberta Energy Regulator (AER) advised Industry of its decision to transition Annual Methane Emission Reporting from OneStop to Petrinex. For additional context, operators are encouraged to review [Annual AER Methane Emissions Reporting Moving to Petrinex](#).

New Petrinex Functionality

The following online processes are available under the Audit Menu:

- Edit Methane Emissions Reporting
- Methane Emissions Report
- Query Methane Emissions Reporting
- Request Methane Emissions Non-Compliance Report

User Setup Requirements:

Your organization's **User Security Administrator (USA)** must complete the following setup steps to enable access for applicable Business Associate (BA) users.

1. Create a **Methane Emissions Reporting Edit Role**
 - Assign the appropriate tasks using the Petrinex Methane Emissions Reporting Edit template, including the following tasks:
 - Edit Methane Emissions
 - Methane Emissions Noncompliance Report
 - Methane Emissions Report
 - Query Methane Submission

- Assign the appropriate tasks using the Petrinex Comprehensive template, including the following tasks:
 - Batch Upload
 - Submit Report Request
- 2. Create a **Methane Emissions Reporting Read Only Role**
 - Assign the appropriate tasks using the Petrinex Methane Emissions Reporting Read Only template, including the following tasks:
 - Methane Emissions Noncompliance Report
 - Methane Emissions Report
 - Query Methane Submission
 - Assign the appropriate tasks using the Petrinex Comprehensive template, including the following tasks:
 - Submit Report Request
- 3. Assign the appropriate role to BA users using the **Manage User ID** functionality.

Alberta Reporting Calendar updates include:

- First Non-Compliance Sweep – Three weeks prior to deadline (May 2026 calendar)
- Second Non-Compliance Sweep – three days prior to the deadline (May 2026 calendar)
- Deadline Day (June 1st or next business day) (June 2026 calendar)
- Rollover – First business day of the calendar year (January 2027 calendar)
