

Alberta Waste Plant Reporting Entrained Gas

Audience: All Alberta Waste Plant Operators

Purpose: Effective June 4th, 2026, Alberta Waste Plant Operators will be able to report Vent and Flare activities in conjunction with the waste reporting code for Entrained Gas (ENTGAS) at waste plants.

Background: [Directive 060: Upstream Petroleum Industry Flaring, Incinerating, and Venting](#) requires all facilities and wells to report flaring and venting activities when they occur. Historically, waste plant operators were limited to reporting tank venting or flaring as standalone volumes, without a corresponding receipt. This reporting limitation caused imbalances for the product GAS at waste plants, as there was no corresponding source to offset the vented or flared volumes. As a result, the waste plant would be out of balance resulting in potential noncompliance.

Action Required: Effective June 4th, waste plant operators with vent and flare activities associated with tanks will be able to balance these volumes with the Waste Reporting Code for ENTGAS. Consistent with conventional volumetric reporting practices, ENTGAS will not be included in the GAS product balancing equation.

This new functionality will be available for both the current month reporting and amendments to historical months.

Operators are encouraged to review and amend historical reporting periods where Venting or Flaring activities occurred but could not previously be associated with the ENTGAS code. Updating these records will help resolve known imbalances and noncompliance with reporting requirements.
